

# Florida Medicaid: Claim and AHCA Data Must Match

The Agency for Healthcare Administration (AHCA) enacted a mandate effective March 1, 2022, requiring all healthcare professionals providing care to Medicaid members to include specific identifiers when filing claims. In accordance with the AHCA's mandate, all claims submitted to Molina must include an appropriate taxonomy code.

The submitted taxonomy should be consistent with an **active** Medicaid Provider record. **Claims with identifier information that doesn't match your provider enrollment data entered with the Agency for Health Care Administration (AHCA) will deny.**

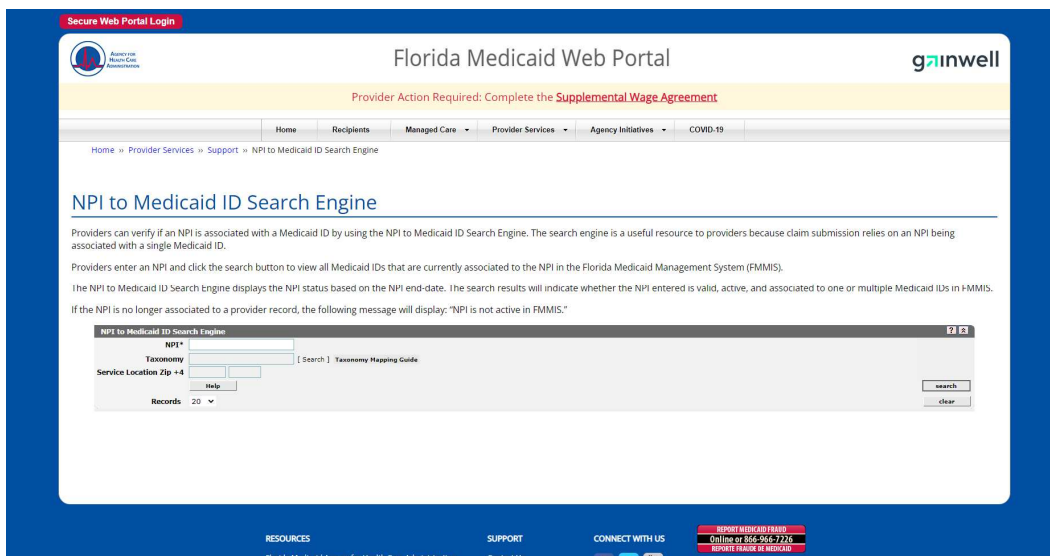
## AHCA requirements

You must include the following information for billing and rendering providers when submitting claims:

- **National Provider Identifier (NPI)** number, as enrolled with Florida Medicaid
- **Taxonomy code** for your services provided in accordance with your enrolled provider type and specialty
- **Address with ZIP+4 code**, as enrolled with Florida Medicaid

Providers can visit the AHCA's NPI to Medicaid ID search engine to verify their State enrollment information:

The PML is provided to Medicaid health plans for purposes of verifying if providers in their networks are enrolled in Medicaid and for reconciling demographic data between the plans' databases and Medicaid.

- Column F of the PML lists the taxonomy code associated with the provider's specialty on file.
- Column O of the PML lists the taxonomy associated with the provider's NPI Crosswalk.
