

# **Provider Memorandum**

### Update to Coverage for Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC)

Molina Healthcare of Illinois (Molina) currently provides coverage of Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) for HealthChoice (Medicaid) members under both the medical (provider billed) and pharmacy benefit (dispensed from a pharmacy).

To align coverage with the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS), Molina Healthcare will stop coverage of LARCs under the pharmacy benefit effective November 1, 2023.

Coverage of LARCs under the medical benefit will continue unchanged.

These LARCs covered under the pharmacy benefit are currently available for providers to administer to members under the **medical benefit** and will continue without change after November 1, 2023.

- Kyleena IUD (Levonorgestrel releasing IUD)
- Liletta IUD (Levonorgestrel IUD)
- Mirena IUD System (Levonorgestrel IUD)
- Nexplanon IMP (Etonogestrel Subdermal Implant)
- Paragard IUD T380A (Copper IUD)
- Skyla IUD (Levonorgestrel releasing IUD)
