DOCUMENTATION TIPS

Aortic ectasia and aneurysms are often incidental findings in CT scans. These conditions cannot be reported based on the radiological procedure alone. The provider must bring the diagnosis into the progress note and document the pertinent findings and treatment.

Diagnosis:

• Site: ascending, descending, abdominal, thoracic, thoracoabdominal

• **Severity**: ectasia, aneurysm

• Contributing factors: atherosclerosis, hypertension, hyperlipidemia, tobacco use

• Complications: dissection, rupture

Status: stable, worsening, requires surgery

Plan: monitor, referral to specialist

Aortic ectasia (not an all-inclusive list)

Document a surgically repaired aneurysm and report Z86.79 Personal history of other diseases of the circulatory system.

DOCUMENTATION AND REPORTING EXAMPLE

CT scan, 2/25/2021 shows abdominal aortic aneurysm, 4 cm. Referral to cardiologist. Repeat CT scan in 6 months. BP 150/80. Hypertension, continue Lisinopril 10 mg, q.d.

I71.4 Abdominal aortic aneurysm, without rupture I10 Hypertension
