

Documentation and Reporting Asthma

DOCUMENTATION TIPS

Accurate documentation of asthma identifies the frequency and severity of attacks, including any exacerbation or status asthmaticus. The provider should address and document specifically the elements that support the level of severity that correlates to the clinical situation:

- **Frequency** – intermittent or persistent
- **Severity** – mild, moderate, severe
- Complication or exacerbation

Document clinical indicators in the absence of an asthma diagnosis:

- Wheezing, especially when exhaling,
- Shortness of breath,
- Excessive coughing,
- Difficulty breathing,
- Chest tightness or pain.

Documentation of **chronic obstructive asthma** is reported with ICD-10-CM diagnosis code J44.9 Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. **Eosinophilic asthma** should be reported with ICD-10-CM diagnosis code J82.83 as well as the correct diagnosis code for asthma by type and severity.

Document and report the patient's:

- Exposure to tobacco smoke
- History of tobacco dependence
- Tobacco dependence
- Tobacco use

Report long-term drug therapy with a code from category Z79 for medications used regularly. Do not report this diagnosis code for rescue medications prescribed on an as needed basis (PRN).

DOCUMENTATION AND REPORTING EXAMPLE

Patient reports wheezing, excessive coughing, difficulty breathing several times a week.

Impression: Mild intermittent asthma, continue albuterol inhaler daily.

J45.20 Mild intermittent asthma, uncomplicated
Z79.899 Other long-term (current) drug therapy



HEDIS: Detailed information about measures related to asthma medication is available through your Passport/Molina Quality Representative.
